2017 RACE SEASON Info Sheet



Dwellingup Dash

RACE 1: Lane Poole Reserve (Baden Powell campsite), Dwellingup: Saturday 17th June and Sunday 18th June, 2017

Dwellingup is approx. 100km south of Perth, off the South West Highway, and the Dwellingup Dash is held in Lane Poole Reserve. Other than at the campsite, accommodation is not provided, so please BYO tent, camper trailer, caravan or RV. Entry fees into the lane poole reserve is **\$12/vehicle**, plus camping fees per night are **\$10.00** per adult (16 years of age or over) and **\$2.20** per child (6yrs – 16yrs), children under 6 years old are free, and will be paid to the rangers on site. The rangers have reserved the Baden Powell campsite for the use of our club for Friday and Saturday night, but this is not exclusive use. The rangers will notify other campers that we have an event going on. Please do not set up camp at the other sites within the Reserve unless you have specifically booked them. At Dwellingup, there is a 5-10 minute dirt road drive to the start line from the campsite There is limited parking space at the race site, it is highly recommended to carpool if able.

RACE INFORMATION PACKS will be sent to all paid entrants with maps and directions a week before the race. If travel to the race and accommodation is required please contact committee for assistance.

Please keep this page and a copy of your entry for your referral. **Please send in separate entry forms for each entrant/driver (even Pee Wee / Mini Pee Wee).** Entry is preferred online through www.wassa.com.au or alternatively by emailing a completed entry form to committee. Multiple class entries for the same driver can be submitted on ONE form. Please check entry forms for the closing dates **as late entries will be subject to a late entry fee.**

Saturday: Race Heat 1- Racing starts at 4.00pm Saturday night. (3:00pm Drivers Meeting *Compulsory*)

Sunday: Race Heat 2- Racing starts at 6.00 am Sunday morning. (5.30am Drivers Meeting *Compulsory*)

Please be ready to leave for the race site straight after the drivers meeting.

Drivers meeting and race start times are subject to change and controlled by the weather conditions on race weekend.

Attendance at Drivers Meetings is compulsory for all drivers. If you are not at the drivers meeting on either day, you will not race that day. Bibs will be allocated and running order of classes will be given at the Drivers Meeting, and the Race Marshall will address possible track hazards and / or changes.

NEW TRIAL CLASS: 2 Dog Veteran

Race Classes/Distance

6 Dog (~6km)	Limited to 6 dogs	Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in more than 2 races
4 Dog (~6km)	Limited to 4 dogs	Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in more than 2 races
3 Dog (~4km)	Limited to 3 dogs	Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in more than 2 races
2 Dog (~4km)	Limited to 2 dogs	Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in more than 2 races
1 Dog (~3.4km)	1 dog only	Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in more than 2 races
Touring (~1.5km)	1 or 2 dog only	Is a non-competitive class open to people not wishing to compete in standard classes
Veteran (~1.5km)	1 or 2 dog only	Is open to dogs over the age of 7 years
Puppy (~1.5km)	1 dog only	Open to medium breeds 9-18 months & larger breeds from 12 months.(committee's adjudication)
Novice (~1.5km)	1 dog only	Is for 1 st year mushers or those who have competed in 2 or less previous sanctioned races
Junior (~1.5km)	1 dog only	Open to children from 10-16 years of age at the beginning of race season
Pee Wee (~0.5km)	1 dog only	Open to children 7-10 years of age, and may elect to have an Adult ride with them
Mini Pee Wee (~0.5km)	1 dog only	Open to children 3 to 6 years of age. Children MUST ride with an Adult.
Cannicross (~1.5km)	1 dog only	Open to all, including dogs that have run earlier in scooter or rig classes
Bikejoring(~3.4km)	1 dog only	Open to dogs over 9 months of age

It is a condition of race entry that you may be asked to assist the committee with various tasks during the event. Please note that race distances are a guide only. Track maps and distances will be available in the race packs.

Helmets **MUST** be worn in ALL classes (except canicross) and scooters/rigs equipped with cable cutters. Bike lights and / or helmet-mounted lights are required to be worn for races run in the dark. Equipment will be checked by the Race or Chute Marshall before each race. Please read the Race Rules (available on the WASSA website) and ask any questions well **BEFORE** the races.

Committee reserves the right to cancel a class if there are not at least 3 entries.

Also note that puppy/touring/novice/junior and veteran *may* be run together depending on number of entrants.
