Race 1 - The Dwellingup dash

- When: **Saturday, Sunday 23rd, 24th June 2018**

Entries close **17th June 2018**. Late entries accepted until **20th June** with a \$10 late fee

- Where: The Lane Poole Reserve, Dwellingup. (Baden Powell Campsite)
- **Accommodation:** designated campsites with space available for tents, camper trailers, caravans and RVs.
- Facilities: long drop toilets
- RACE INFORMATION PACKS will be sent to all paid entrants with maps and directions the week before the race.
- **LANE POOLE FEES:** \$13/vehicle, plus camping fees per night are \$11.00 per adult (16 years of age or over) and \$3.00 per child (6yrs – 16yrs), children under 6 years old are free, \$7.00 for concession card holders, and will be paid to the rangers on site.

Saturday Race Heat 1: Race starts 4.00pm Saturday afternoon. (3.00pm Drivers Meeting *Compulsory*)

Sunday Race Heat 2: Race starts 6:00am Sunday morning. (5:30am Drivers Meeting *Compulsory*)

Drivers meeting and race start times are subject to change and controlled by the weather conditions on race weekend.

Attendance at Drivers Meetings is compulsory for all drivers. If you are not at the drivers meeting on either day, you will not race that day. Bibs will be allocated and running order of classes will be given at the Drivers Meeting,

People bringing straw bedding for dogs MUST clean up after themselves before leaving

For medium breeds 9-18 months & larger breeds from 12 months. (committee's adjudication). Can stay in Puppy for the duration of the season.

For 1st year mushers or those who have competed in 3 or less races

For children from 10-16 years of age at the beginning of race season

For children 8-10 years of age, and may elect to have an Adult ride with them

For children 3 to 7 years of age. Children MUST ride with an Adult.

For people >16 years old & can include a dog previously entered in a scooter or rig class

For children aged 10-16 Years, Dogs must be over 9 months of age

Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in >3 Touring classes

Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in >3 Touring classes **NEW!!**

Please note that 2 dog and 3 dog classes will be run together (subjected to change depending on entries)

Please note that 4 dog and 6 dog classes will be run together (subjected to change depending on entries)

Please note that race distances are a guide only. Track maps and distances will be available in the race packs.

Please send in separate entry forms for each entrant/driver (even Pee Wee / Mini Pee Wee). Entry is preferred online through www.wassa.com.au. Alternatively by emailing a completed entry form to committee.

Please check entry forms for the closing dates **as late entries will be subject to a late entry fee.**

- Helmets MUST be worn in ALL classes (except canicross)
- Bike lights and / or helmet-mounted lights are required to be worn for races run in the dark.
- scooters/rigs/bikes equipped with cable cutters
- Equipment will be checked by the Race/chute marshall before each race

Please read the Race Rules (available on the WASSA website) and ask any questions well BEFORE the races.

Committee reserves the right to cancel a class if there are not at least 3 entries.

Also note that puppy/touring/novice/junior and veteran *may* be run together depending on number of entrants.
