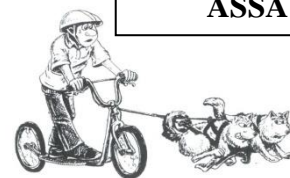

# The Hampton Hoon

## **RACE 3: Hampton View Homestead, Mount Hampton, WA. Saturday and Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> August**

WASSA is delighted to be returning to the Hampton Homestead for the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> August 2017. In the heart of the Wheatbelt, the Hampton View Homestead is a small farmstay about 70 kms Southwest of Southern Cross. The race site is approximately a 3.5 hour drive from Midland. The Hampton Hoon will be a 2 heat event with heats being run Saturday evening and Sunday morning. Entrants are welcome to travel and stay over on Friday night however an extra \$20 per vehicle is required for the extra night of accommodation. Drivers should note that there is an approximately 110 km of dirt road from the main highway to the race site, which will be freshly graded in the week before our race and easily accessible in 2WD vehicles. Maps will be provided in the Race Packs.

RACE PACKS will be sent to all paid entrants with maps, directions and catering info a week before the race. If travel to the race and accommodation is required please contact committee for assistance.

Please keep this page and a copy of your entry for your referral. **Please send in separate entry forms for each entrant/driver (even Pee Wee / Mini Pee Wee).** Entry is preferred online through [www.wassa.com.au](http://www.wassa.com.au), or alternatively by emailing a completed entry form to committee. Multiple class entries for the same driver can be submitted on ONE form. Please check entry forms for the closing dates **as late entries will be subject to a late entry fee.**

**Saturday Race Heat 1:** Race starts 4:00pm Saturday afternoon. (3:00pm Drivers Meeting *Compulsory*)

**Sunday Race Heat 2:** Race starts 6:00am Sunday morning. (5:30am Drivers Meeting *Compulsory*)

Drivers meeting and race start times are subject to change and controlled by the weather conditions on race weekend.

**Attendance at Drivers Meetings is compulsory for all drivers.** If you are not at the drivers meeting on either day, you will receive penalties. Bibs will be allocated and running order of classes will be given at the Drivers Meeting, and the Race Marshall will address possible track hazards and / or changes.

It is a condition of race entry that you may be asked to assist the committee with various tasks during the event.

Accommodation at the Hampton View Homestead race will be basic bush camping only, with plenty of space available for tents, camper trailers, caravans and RVs. The owners have installed long-drop toilets at the site. Hampton Homestead has limited indoor accommodation ~10kms from the event site. The event is partly catered if you choose to take advantage of it (Saturday dinner and Sunday breakfast) Fees for the catering are listed below. A new cappuccino machine will also be available to sell drinks, hot chips and toasties can also be bought all day from the shearing shed. There will be very limited drinking water available on site, so please plan to bring enough for you and your dogs for the weekend. Nearest store once you arrive on site is 70kms away in Southern Cross!

**People bringing straw bedding for dogs MUST clean up after themselves before leaving**

**\*Current listed costs are from 2016. Prices will most likely remain the same, but are still being confirmed\***

**Accommodation fees:** for the weekend is \$20 per vehicle per night.

**Catering fees:** Catering Saturday night and Sunday morning is included with the race fee for each driver entering at Hampton Hoon. For additional people not competing, the following fees apply: \$15 Saturday Dinner, \$10 Sunday Breakfast. Hot drinks and snacks will also be available to purchase throughout the day.

**NOTE:** Please Email the Catering Form on page 4 to committee, alternatively please let committee know if you are interested in eating the catering food, for how many people, and any special dietary requirements.

## RACE CLASSES/ DISTANCE

6 Dog (~6.7km)	Limited to 6 dogs	Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in more than 5 open classes
4 Dog (~5.6km)	Limited to 4 dogs	Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in more than 5 open classes
3 Dog (~5.6km)	Limited to 3 dogs	Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in more than 5 open classes
2 Dog (~4.8km)	Limited to 2 dogs	Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in more than 3 races
1 Dog (~3km)	1 dog only	Open to dogs over 12 months of age & mushers who have raced in more than 3 races
Touring (~2km)	1 or 2 dog only	Is a non-competitive class open to people not wishing to compete in standard classes
Veteran (~2km)	1 or 2 dog only	Is open to dogs over the age of 7 years
Puppy (~2km)	1 dog only	Open to medium breeds 9-18 months & larger breeds from 12 months.(committee's adjudication)
Novice (~2km)	1 dog only	Is for 1st year mushers or those who have competed in 2 or less previous sanctioned races
Junior (~2km)	1 dog only	Open to children from 10-16 years of age at the beginning of race season
Pee Wee (~0.5km)	1 dog only	Open to children 7-10 years of age, and may elect to have an Adult ride with them
Mini Pee Wee (~0.5km)	1 dog only	Open to children 3 to 6 years of age. Children MUST ride with an Adult.
Cannicross (~2km)	1 dog only	Open to all, including dogs that have run earlier in scooter or rig classes
Junior Cannicross (~2km)	1 dog only	Open to children aged between 14 – 16 Years, Dogs must be over 9 months of age
Bikejoring(~3km)	1 dog only	Open to dogs over 9 months of age

**Please note that 4 dog and 6 dog classes will be run together (subjected to change)**

**Please note that 2 dog and 3 dog classes will be run together (subjected to change)**

**Please note that race distances are a guide only. Track maps and distances will be available in the race packs.**

Helmets MUST be worn in ALL classes (except canicross) and scooters/rigs equipped with cable cutters. Bike lights and / or helmet-mounted lights are required to be worn for races run in the dark. Equipment will be checked by the Race or Chute Marshall before each race. Please read the Race Rules (available on the WASSA website) and ask any questions well BEFORE the races.

**Committee reserves the right to cancel a class if there are not at least 3 entries.**

**Also note that puppy/touring/novice/junior and veteran *may* be run together depending on number of entrants.**

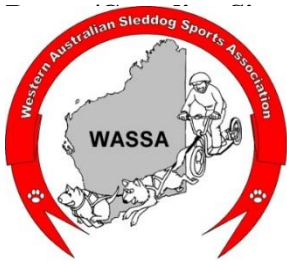
